



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY
TALLASSEE, FLORIDA, USA

AND

HIMGIRI NABH VISHWAVIDYALAYA
(UNIVERSITY IN THE SKY)
DEHRA DUN, UTTARAKHAND, INDIA

Himgiri Nabh Vishwavidyalaya (the University in the Sky) located in the City of Dehradun, Uttarakhand, India and The Florida State University located in the City of Tallahassee, Florida, USA (hereafter referred to as "FSU"), agree to the following terms:

In order to promote cooperation, the two institutions will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculties, departments and research centers in a number of academic areas, including initially: Communication, Education, Marketing, and Hospitality Management.

Within the above fields, the following general forms of cooperation are anticipated:

- Visits by and interchange of faculty for research, teaching and institutional development.
- Exchange of information including but not limited to library materials and research publications.
- Visits by and exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for instruction and research. (The nature, duration and funding of student visits and exchanges will be spelled out in separate written agreements).
- Joint research activities, the details of which will be spelled out in separate written agreements mutually agreed to by both parties.

The substance and scheduling of specific activities will be the responsibility of a Joint Planning Committee. This committee also will monitor the implementation and results of the activities. For purposes of this agreement, the members of the Joint Planning Committee representing FSU are: Dr. John K. Mayo, Dean, College of Communication, Dr. Stephen McDowell, Chair, Department of Communication; Dr. King Beach, Associate Professor, Socio-cultural and International Development Studies (SIDES), Dr. Robert Brymer, Director, Dedman School of Hospitality; and Dr. Gary Knight, Associate Professor, Department of Marketing. The members representing HNV are: Dr. K.B. Budhori, Dean, Faculty of Education; Dr. Anita Dighe, Director, Distance Education and Communication, and Mr. J.S. Jolly, Board Member, E-City School of Cinema, Hospitality and Retail (ESCHR).

Both parties acknowledge that all financial arrangements will be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds. This agreement shall remain in force for a period of three (3) consecutive years from the date it is signed with the understanding that it may be revised by mutual consultation and consent. Either party may rescind the agreement with a six-month notice sent by registered letter with an acknowledgment of receipt.

Before becoming operative, the present agreement will be submitted to the administrative and supervising offices of the co-signing parties. It will become effective after being signed by the presidents of the two universities.


