
**Memorandum of Understanding
between**

In order to promote educational and academic exchanges, and to achieve a successful and sustainable partnership, Himgiri Nabh Vishwavidyalaya (University in the Sky) and the University of Regina endorse this Memorandum of Understanding.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact, educational and research cooperation between their constituents, including students, faculty members and staff, departments and research institutes, and will endeavour to cooperate in the fields with which both institutions are concerned. Within spheres that are mutually agreed to, both institutions agree on promoting the following forms of cooperation:

1. Exchange of students for study and research, and for short term cultural and academic experience to Dehradun and Regina;
2. Within agreed upon programs, develop agreements that would permit full transfer credit for students attending either institution for a semester of study;
3. Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures and discussions;
4. Exploration of a Joint International Degree Programs (Undergraduate and Graduate) in areas to be determined.

In the first instance, both institutions will work together to establish a degree program to be delivered by Himgiri Nabh Vishwavidyalaya (University in the Sky) with academic oversight provided by the University of Regina.

Both institutions will undertake to establish the formal parameters of the partnership and put in place an operational plan within eighteen months, with a goal to enrol the first students in Fall 2008. To achieve this goal in a timely fashion a minimum of two follow-up working visits will be committed to at the signing of this MOU. The first follow-up working meeting is to occur before May 31, 2007 in New Delhi, India or other agreed upon location.

The proposed initial program will be in Fine Arts – Media Production and Studies (this would permit programs in film, television, video, new media and communication studies), with a long-term goal of increasing the range of programs offered by mutual agreement and dependent on market demand.

Both institutions agree that the programming will be a combination of traditional classroom instruction, technology enhanced learning and practical internships, as required.

Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will be negotiated and identified in a Partnership Agreement and implementation plan prior to the commencement of the associated activities.


It is understood that the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding will commence on the day of signature, and will continue thereafter for five years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Representatives from both institutions will discuss the terms of a renewal at least six months prior to the natural termination of the current Memorandum of Understanding.
